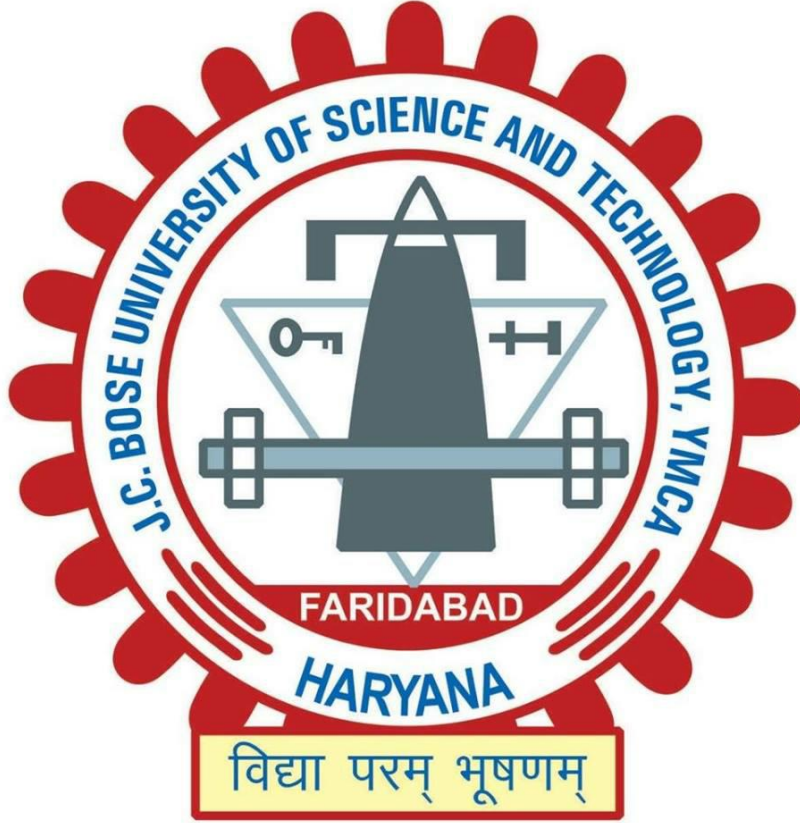

<p>RPB/06/03</p>	<p>To Apprise about the details of Ph.D. Scholars admitted in academic year 2020-21 and passed out in academic year 2019-20</p> <p>It is submitted that 50 students got admitted in Ph.D. in the academic year 2020-21, out of which five withdrew their admissions (attached as Annexure 2).</p> <p>Further, from this session 2020-21:</p> <p>i) 7 seats have been granted to our University by AICTE under AICTE Doctoral Fellowship Program (ADF). As per ADF, fellowship amount of Rs. 31000/- pm+HRA is admissible for 2 years and 35000/- pm+HRA in third year. 4 students were admitted under this scheme, out of which one has withdrawn. Seats against reserved category could not be filled.</p> <p>ii) 6 admissions have been made under Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies.</p> <p>It is also apprised that till date 91 Ph.D. scholars have been awarded Ph.D. Degree by the University. Only in academic year 2019-20, 26 Ph.D. scholars were awarded Ph.D. degree (attached as Annexure 3)</p>
<p>RPB/06/04</p>	<p>To Consider & Approve the Fee Structure for Ph.D. Programme from the Session 2021-22</p> <p>It is submitted that University is charging the fee from Ph.D. scholars as per the fee structure given below:</p> <p>Existing Fee Structure</p> <p>i) Fee for Pre Ph.D. Course: Rs. 10000/- ii) Registration fee: Rs. 3000/- one time. iii) Tuition fee: Rs. 10000/- per semester. iv) Tuition fee (for University Employees): Rs. 5000/- per semester. v) Caution Money (Refundable): Rs. 5000/- one time.</p> <p>Now one more course has been compulsorily added to Ph.D. program as 'Research and Publication Ethics' from session 2020-21 (Even Sem.) as per UGC letter F.1-1/2018 dated Dec. 2019 (attached as Annexure 4), which has increased our expenses. Besides, the fees being taken are same since the program was started in 2010. The proposed fee structure for the Ph.D. programme w.e.f. July 2021 session is given below:</p> <p>Proposed Fee Structure</p> <p>1. Pre-Ph.D. Course fee : Rs.15000/- (At the time of admission) Rs. 7500/- (for University employees)</p>

RPB/06/05	<p>To Apprise the house about research award & seed money</p> <p>It is submitted that seven faculty members and 3 students were granted cash awards worth Rs. 1,43,747/- for research publications during 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019 in SCI/SCIE indexed journals as per University Research Policy.</p> <p>The process of awarding cash prizes for research publications during 1st April 2019 to 31st March 2020 is also in final stages.</p> <p>It is also submitted that in 2020, seed money for research worth Rs. 8 lakhs (approx.) were granted to 4 faculty members to promote research culture in the University.</p> <p>Seed money grant for 2021 is under process and we have received 29 research projects to be scrutinized by the constituted committee.</p>
RPB/06/06	<p>To Consider & Approve the Budget for R&D</p> <p>It is submitted that the grant for Research & Development may please be increased to motivate faculty members, research scholars, staff and students to provide appropriate facilities and infrastructure for the advancement of research and to organize research promotion events like research paper awards, seed money, summits, conferences, seminars, workshops, expert lectures and panel discussion through talks with eminent personalities from reputed institutions and industries etc.</p> <p>At present, a budget of Rs.1.30 Crore is approved from Vice Chancellor and is to be put in the forthcoming meeting of Finance Committee. RPB/06/07	<p>To Consider the Cases of Ph.D. Scholars who render the Fake Publications.</p> <p>It has come to our notice that few Research Scholars have submitted their thesis containing SCI/Scopus indexed research publications which were fake. To deal with such cases of fake publications, some penalties are to be imposed for those who indulge in malpractices.</p> <p>In case of any fake publication being found in the thesis of a Ph.D. scholar, penalties may be imposed based on the severity of the case, such as Ph.D. admission of that scholar may be cancelled along with demotion of internal supervisor/faculty members, or any other strict action may be taken.</p>

	<p>The Publication not being shown under Ph.D. thesis will not be taken into account for imposing any penalty.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>

In view of above, it is proposed that number of pages in thesis should not be less than 100 (containing atleast 50 pages of actual work) should be adopted, excluding the supporting pages and reference.</p> <p>It is also proposed that Ph.D. thesis should follow a standard pattern as suggested by UGC-Inflibnet.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>
RPB/06/11	<p>To Consider & Approve the Ph.D. Admission Criteria on the basis of Entrance Test/NET Qualified only, if not found suitable (other option to be included)</p> <p>It is submitted that as on date the Ph.D. admissions is done on the basis of entrance test or through exemptions as per UGC guidelines. In this regard, the existing Ph.D. admission criteria for preparation of</p>

	<p>merit list is as below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) 70% marks from the entrance*/70% marks to the candidates exempted from entrance. b) 5% marks of the percentage of marks in the Master's degree. c) 10% marks in the interview to be conducted by the respective Department. d) 5% marks for work experience (01 mark per year for experience subject to max.5 marks). e) 5% marks (01 marks for each publication in UGC approved list of Journals subjected to max.5 marks) f) 5% marks for entitlement of fellowship / scholarship from outside organizations such as CSIR, UGC, QIP, DST, AICTE etc. <p>It is necessary to mention here that the candidate qualifying through entrance exam is at a loss as his marks scored are considered on actual basis of entrance test score. While candidate qualifying through exemption scores full marks as 70%. The entrance exam should be qualifying only instead of being a part of making merit list. Also, there is no provision to opt out a candidate who is not found suitable for pursuing research work. Hence, it is proposed that an option of not found suitable may also be included for admission purpose in Ph.D. programme.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>
RPB/06/12	<p>To Consider & Approve to Keep Waiting List for Ph.D. Candidates to maintain consistency in strength in Ph.D. Admissions.</p> <p>It is submitted that it has been noticed that after Ph.D. list is out and candidates are asked to submit their fees, few of them do not join the course. Even some of them who joined, leave within a week or two. To cope up with such conditions, it is proposed to prepare a waiting list of Ph.D. candidates simultaneously who can replace those Ph.D. scholars who left out of Ph.D. course within two weeks. It will help to maintain consistency in Ph.D. admissions.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>

	<p>It is proposed to allow Ph.D. scholars to submit their half-yearly progress reports through online mode. Such submissions should be within a given time frame 15th-30th May / 15th-30th Nov. each year.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>
RPB/06/14	<p>To Consider & Approve the Time Limit of one year for Course Work & Registration from the date of enrollment</p> <p>It is proposed to consider and approve the time limit of course work within a year from the date of enrollment. The registration process must be completed within 3 months of completion of course work.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>
RPB/06/15	<p>To approve Research Advisory Committee Constitution</p> <p>As per UGC Guidelines, a Research Advisory Committee (RAC) must be constituted for each Ph.D. scholar. The proposed constitution of the committee with minimum three members (not exceeding five members) is as follows:</p> <p>(a) One expert in the field from the Department/Centre; (b) One faculty expert, preferably in the concerned area, either from outside the Department/Centre to which the student belongs or a different university; and (c) Supervisor(s). Experts at (a) and (b) above shall be nominated by Dean (R&D) from amongst those proposed by Supervisor(s).</p> <p>With each member having :- a) Total work experience of minimum five years b) Post Ph.D. experience of minimum three years</p> <p>RAC must have at least one professor. External members may be opted satisfying above criteria. Supervisor experience will be considered as per Ph.D. Ordinance.</p> <p>Research Advisory Committee and its functions: 1. The Research Supervisor of the scholar shall be the Convener of this Committee. This Committee shall have the following responsibilities: 1.1 To review the research proposal and finalize the topic of research; 1.2 To guide the research scholar to develop the study design and methodology of research and identify the course(s) that he/she may have to do. 1.3 To periodically review and assist in the progress of the research work of the research scholar. 2. A research scholar shall appear before the Research Advisory Committee once in six months to make a presentation of the progress of his/her work for evaluation and further guidance. The six monthly progress reports shall be submitted by the Research Advisory Committee to the</p>

	<p>department with a copy to the research scholar.</p> <p>3. In case the progress of the research scholar is unsatisfactory, the Research Advisory Committee shall record the reasons for the same and suggest corrective measures. If the research scholar fails to implement these corrective measures, the Research Advisory Committee may recommend to the department with specific reasons for cancellation of the registration of the research scholar.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>
RPB/06/16	<p>To Consider and Approve Research & Publication Ethics (RPE) Subject in Course work with 02 Credits to be included in point 9 (viii) of Ph.D. Ordinance.</p> <p>It is submitted that as per UGC letter no. D.O. No. F-1/2018 (Journal/CARE) dated December 2019, the Research & Publication Ethics Subject needs to be included in the Course work of Ph.D. Programme. The Course work is of two credits, the same needs to be included as part of as Pre-Ph.D. Course Programme of the University.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>

After Pre-Ph.D. submission, it generally takes 1-2 years for Ph.D. award. Similarly, for those Ph.D. scholars admitted in 2012 have exhausted their time period in 2020.</p> <p>Hence, it is proposed that Ph.D. scholars who got admitted in the year 2011 & 2012 (registered till 2013) but has not submitted their Pre-Ph.D. submission till date; his/her Ph.D. admission may be cancelled.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>

This scholarship was being paid through TEQIP-III fund and was increased to Rs. 25,000/-, Annexure attached as no. 5.</p> <p>It is proposed to continue with this increased amount of Ph.D. scholarship for newly admitted full time Ph.D. scholars to be payable through University research fund or any other fund as per availability.</p> <p>The item is placed for its consideration and approval please.</p>

The Board suggests that these cases should be put in Academic council meeting after the approval of DRC. The Board is of the view that it does not have the authority to take decision in this matter.

The board was updated about the research award day and it is suggested that same should be reported in Academic council. For release of award money, it is resolved that to curb any malpractice in research a certificate/affidavit should be taken from the authors that no publication fee/open access fee/editing fee/any other kind of fee has been paid by him/her.

It is resolved that 2 nd phase of inviting research projects by the faculty should be started and seed money of 2 lakhs should be granted to the projects selected by due process. However those faculties granted funds in the first phase but they have not utilized it/not completed the project/ not submitted the closure report should be banned for applying project this time.
Item 5.6	To consider the policy for awarding the faculty for patent. The award money of Rs. 50000/ is approved by the board for the faculty granted patent. The board approved in principal that patent policy of the university should be framed by IPR cell and faculty should be made aware to get patent by conducting workshops etc.

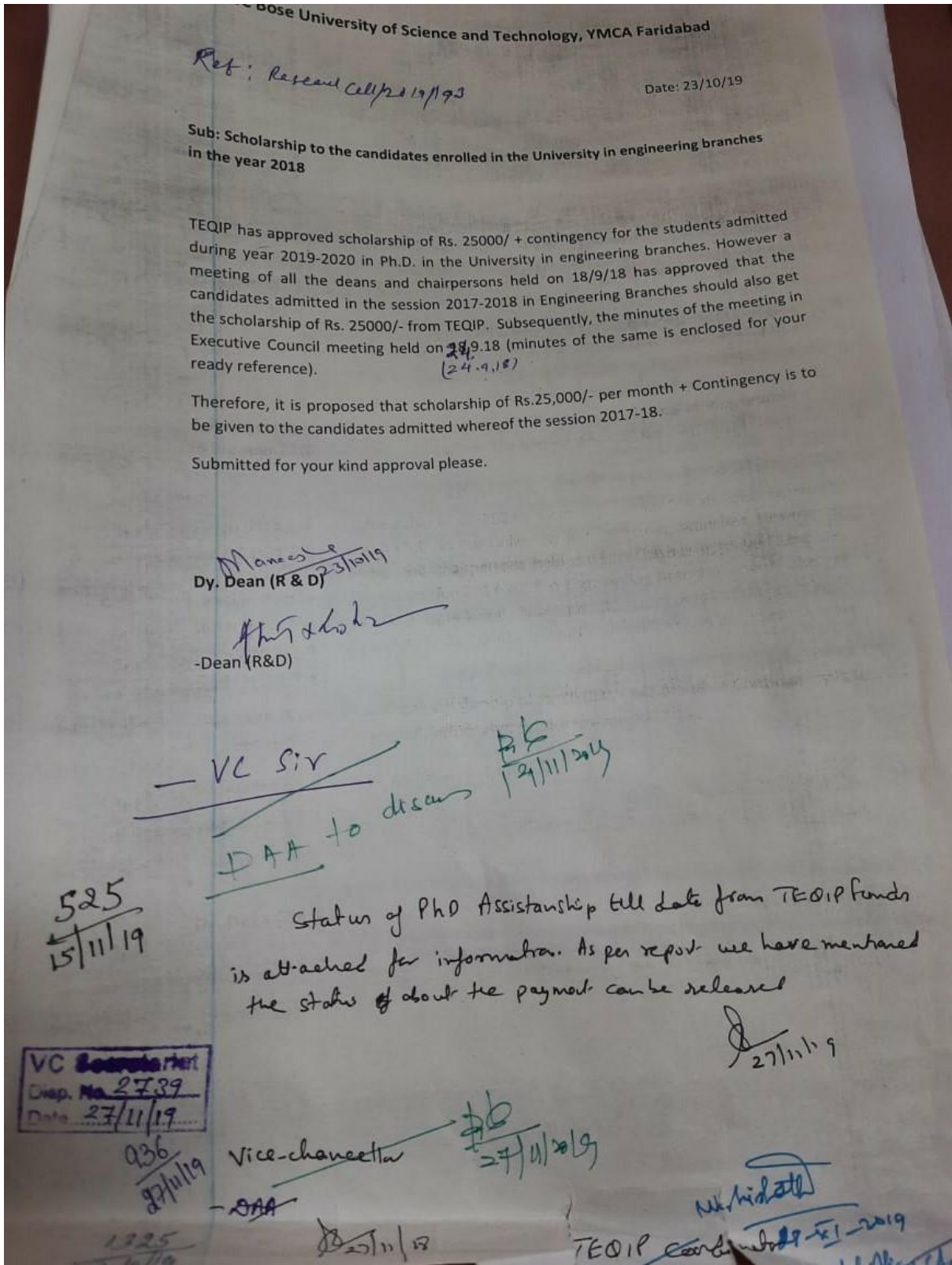

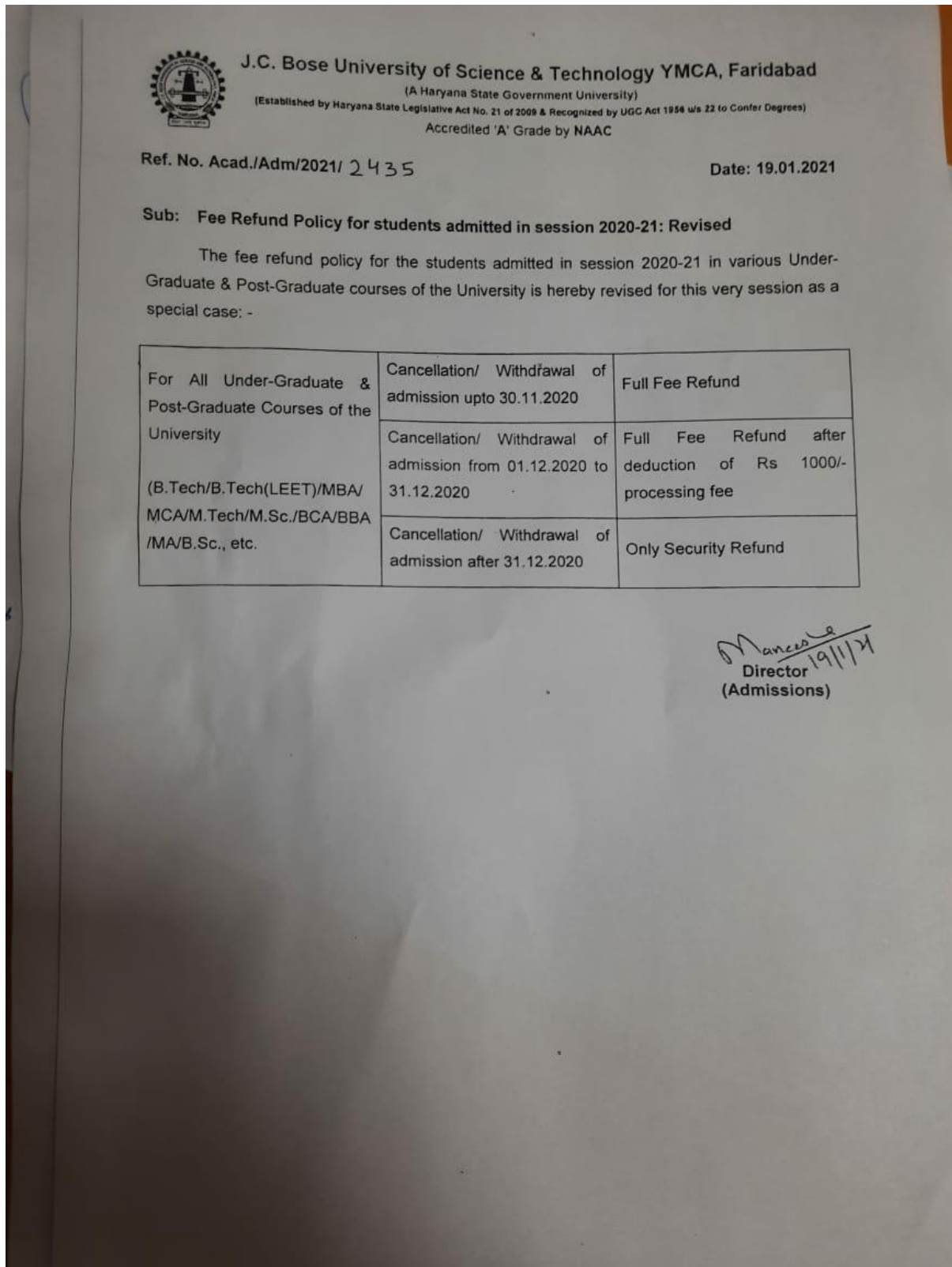
