## **ABOUT UNIVERSITY LIBRARY**

The Central Library of the University has been named after the great Indian thinker and leader Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyay. The Library was established in 1969 and shifted in present building in January 2008. It is situated at ground floor with air conditioned facility. The Library is well equipped with modern technology like e-library Portal, Bar Code Technology, Remote Access facility, Federated Search, use of Artificial Intelligence for searching through voice command, Mobile App etc. It is fully automated with Web Based Library Management System 'LSEase' from LIBSYS Ltd. Web OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) facility is available to know the availability of books in the library.

Library is having total collection of more than 83000 print books. More than 3400 e-journals are being subscribed from the reputed publishers to promote the research activities in the University. More than 7000 titles of e-books from reputed publishers are also accessible to the users. Library is also having access of millions of e-books from World eBook Library and South Asian Archive. Library is also subscribing 35 magazines, 16 daily newspapers and more than 125 print research journals for its users. Central Library is also having membership of DELNET and e-Shodh Sindhu consortia.

### **e-Books:**

Library is having access of more than 7000 titles of e-Books i.e. McGraw-Hill e-books (116), Trittech e-books (329), Pearson e-books (127), Elsevier (8) as well as EBSCO e-books (6723).

### **JCBoseUST e-Library Portal:**

JCBOSEUST e-Library Portal provides access to more than 6 Lakh e-resources 24\*7 from anywhere. These e-resources include e-journals, e-books, expert lectures, video tutorials, e-newspapers, e-magazines, e-contents developed by own faculty members etc.

Federated search facility is available to search relevant documents out of all e-resources in a single click. Artificial Intelligence based chatbot called ILA search is also available for searching. Mobile App is available to access e-Library Portal on smart phones too.
