Sh. Raj Nehru, Vice Chancellor and Chairperson IQAC, chaired the meeting. The meeting started with the welcome of all the members by the Chair. The following agenda items were discussed in the meeting:

#### 15.1 To approve the minutes of 14th IQAC meeting held on 02.09.2021

The house was informed that the minutes were circulated to the all members of IQAC and no comments were received.

The house approved the minutes of 14th IQAC meeting.

# 15.2 To apprise the members about the status of action taken on minutes of 14th IQAC meeting held on 02.09.2021

Action Taken report status on the  $14^{th}$  meeting of IQAC was explained to the house in detail.

Noted by the house without any further comments/suggestion.

#### 15.3 To report about the ISO certification to the University

Members congratulated for getting the ISO Certifications on the following;

a. ISO 9001:2015 for Quality Management System

b. ISO 14001:2015 for Environmental Management System

#### 15.4 To inform about the status of NAAC Cycle 2 accreditation

Members of the house noted the activities related to NAAC accreditation process starting from the submission of IIQA and subsequent submission of SSR on 16.11.2021.

It was also suggested that the concerned Criteria Coordinators must review the qualitative aspects/parameters in terms of dissemination / updation for presenting them before ensuing NAAC Peer Team during their visit.

Action to be taken by: NAAC Coordinator

### 15.5 To report classroom feedback of Teachers under 360 degree feedback

Department –wise report of feedback along with the action taken by the respective chairpersons on the classroom teaching was presented in the meeting. The house noted the same.

House noted that the university also conducts a number of surveys from stakeholders under 360 degree feedback practices such as Classroom feedback, curricula feedback, facilities etc.

Further, it was desired that all the department Chairpersons must maintain the proper detailed record of the same for past five years. Centrally, such record to be maintained at IQAC.

Action to be taken by: Department Chairpersons & Director IQAC

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## 15.6 To report about the feedback and action taken on the Facilities and Infrastructure.

Feedback report on facilities and infrastructure and its action taken was discussed at length during the meeting. Members felt that in general the responses from the students were satisfactory but there is still an ample room for improvement on many points particularly on the parameters of;

- a. Accessibility of Wi-Fi and internet speed,
- b. Canteen food prices and hygiene,
- c. Cleanliness and lighting of washrooms
- d. Quality of water supply
- e. Availability of doctors and medicine

It was felt by Student member Mr. Chirag that there is a lack of awareness among the students regarding upgradation of some of facilities.

Prof Dinesh Kumar suggested that concerned officers should take care of these facilities for further improvement and plan for action. He also added that new multifloor Hostel mess and canteen is under construction and that will have positive impact.

Vice Chancellor Shri Raj Nehru suggested that sub-committees should be formed by involving concerned officials in order to monitor and improve the quality of various facilities by proposing their action plan/ action points. The action plan for each item of survey be made based on the score achieved and a target be identified for improvement in %age (e.g minimum 20%). The actions be identified around how to achieve the target.

Registrar informed that necessary instructions have been sent to the concerned.

# Action to be taken by : Concerned officials through Director IQAC and Registrar

#### 15.7 To report about the NBA accreditation of MBA program

It was informed that Masters in Business Administration (MBA) programme of Department of Management Studies has been accredited for 3 years by NBA after their visit during 25<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> September 2021.

Members of the house noted and congratulated for the same.

#### 15.8 To report about the new initiatives/activities taken up by the University

- (a) The house was informed that Department of Environmental Science & Engineering in association with Construction & Maintenance Department of University has developed a Horticulture Centre in the university premises Earlier, Greenhouse was developed in 2020, but now the area has been extended into a Horticulture Centre by adding the following.
  - i. Herbal Garden
  - ii. Composting Unit
  - iii. Vegetable Garden
- iv. University Nursery

Prof. Dinesh Kumar suggested that the department may further develop the vertical wall gardening due to lack of space in the University.

Prof. Dilbaghi suggested that students may be involved through Projects and club activities

#### Action to be taken by: Chairperson- EVS

(b) Activities done during the last four months were noted by the house. However, it was felt that reporting of activities should be done more efficiently on ERP portal.

The house noted about the developed of indigenous ERP portal in the University and showed concern about updating of activities on it by respective in-charges. Prof. Arshad Siddiquee suggested that all the activities may be categorized and respective committees may be made responsible for getting the data collected. Prof. Shalini Singh added that the timely uploading of activities to the ERP is the responsibility of all.

Vice Chancellor desired that Registrar may take it up by asking all to update it on regular basis. He also discussed on the issue of possibility of involving updation as a regular practice.

Action to be taken by: Registrar

#### 15.9 To consider and approve the AQAR (2020-21) for submission

It was desired by the house that the AQAR 2020-21 should be submitted one week prior to the last date after incorporating the suggestions received from concerned reviewers/officers. Further, since AISHE details are pre-requisite for submission of AQAR, the process of submission of AISHE data should be accelerated.

VC desired that further subcommittees may be formed to expedite the process of AISHE Data submission, if required.

#### Action to be taken by: Coordinator -AISHE/Registrar

#### 15.10 Any other item with the permission of the Chair

House noted that faculty members of the university have got the 04 DST projects in the month of December 2021.

Dr. Krishan Kant applauded the progress in the university and suggested that the data presentation and communication is also important.

In his concluding remarks Vice chancellor congratulated for getting the ISO certifications and emphasized on improving the ratings of feedback by enhancing the quality of facilities where there are some points of concern. He specifically thanked the outside members for their participation and constructive suggestions.

The meeting ended with thanks to the Chair.
