WEBINAR ON HINDI JOURNALISM

Faridabad: A webinar on the topic of "Hindi journalism- today and tomorrow" was organised by JC Bose University of Science and Technology, YMCA, Faridabad, to commemorate "Hindi Patrakarita Diwas". The webinar was part of the ongoing webinar series titled "Media Ki Baat - Aapke Sath" organised by the department of communications and media technology of the university. The keynote speaker, Padma Shri Alok Mehta, a veteran journalist and writer, emphasised on the need of positive reporting in the media to instill confidence and create awareness among people during the Covid pandemic. The veteran journalist said although Udant Martand, the first Hindi newspaper of India, was published from Calcutta in 1826, it awakened the people of India for Independence. He said that since then, the Indian media has undergone through many technical and content-based changes.
