The Parakram Diwas Declamation Competition was held to commemorate the bravery and valor of India's armed forces and to honor the sacrifices made by soldiers in the line of duty. The competition was held on the occasion of Parakram Diwas,

which is celebrated on 23rd Jan, 2023, 127th birth anniversary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose by the Department of Business Studies from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm for B.com(H) students under chairperson Dr. Manisha Goel. Dr. Pallavi Mahajan and Ms. Radhika Sharma, faculty department of Business Studies coordinated the event along with the students of B.com (H) Kanishka and Devanshi. In 2021, Subhash Chandra Bose Jayanti was announced to be observed as Parakram Diwas. Netaji was a man who inspired thousands of youths to fight for freedom against the Britishers' rule.



The competition was designed to encourage them to express their views on the importance of bravery, courage, and sacrifice in today's world. Participants were required to deliver a speech on a selected theme, which was related to the ideals of Parakram Diwas. All students participated in the event with great zeal and enthusiasm. 17 students participated in competition and presented their views on the relevance of Ideology of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose in the Modern world.



His quote ‘Give me your blood, and I shall give you freedom’ still remains one of the iconic freedom quotes that played a pivotal role in the freedom movement of India. Born in a wealthy Bengali family, Subhash Chandra Bose is entitled with the formation of the first Indian National Army (known as Azad Hind Fauj) who fought for the freedom of India against the British Indian Army in Burmese territory.



Subhas Chandra Bose was given the title of Netaji by the Indian soldiers of the Indische Legion and by the German and Indian officials in the Special Bureau for India in Berlin in early 1942. Even the brave Subhas Chandra Bose couldn't change his fate; on August 18, 1945, his plane crashed and he died tragically. Many critics, however, refuse to believe the ideas put forth by various government organizations, and many believe he miraculously survived the plane crash and lived as a hermit for a while in northern India. In India, the mystery surrounding his final days is still a heated topic.



One of the highlights of the competition was the passion and energy displayed by the participants. Their speeches were delivered with conviction and enthusiasm, and many of the participants received standing ovations from the audience. The competition was a huge success, with students delivering powerful and thought-provoking speeches on a range of topics, including the role of soldiers in maintaining national security, the sacrifices made by soldiers and their families, and the importance of fostering a sense of patriotism among the youth of the country.
