**Manuscript:** The manuscript should be of 3000-4000 words (A-4 size page, 1.5 line spacing, and 12-point Times New Roman font). The authors must submit their original work only. There should not be any infringement of existing copyrights or indulgence in plagiarism.

**Tables and Figures:** The tables and figures should be placed in the appropriate location in the paper. Format and size of all the tables should be same and should be numbered consecutively.

**References:** References should be complete in all respects in APA style 7<sup>th</sup> edition.

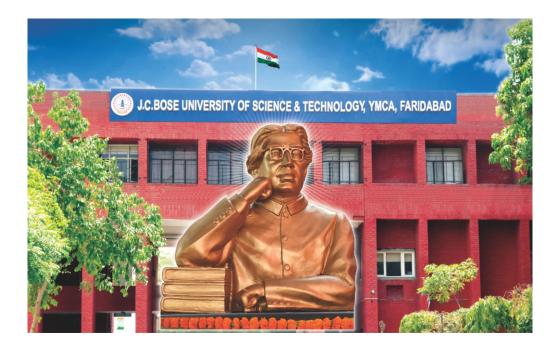
