
# Report On World Population Day (11 July, 2021)




The session culminated with a vote of thanks given by Dr. Bindu mangla.


## Report on Nelson Mandela quiz

Students showcased their artistic skills and creativity by making beautiful paper bags and decorating them vibrantly. Many students showed their active participation which was around 40.


















#### Report on 1 Day BMI Check-Up Camp

#### FIT India Run 2.0 Marathon



The event ended successfully because of all the NSS volunteers who worked with great dedication and hardwork to make this event successful.








## Report on One Day Skill Development Camp










#### Report on 26 January 2022 Debate on Covid-19




# Report of Day 1 of 7-day Camp





NSS Student Coordinators and Technical team volunteers worked efficiently to make this competition a grand success.




# Report on JAL-DARSHAN: ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION under 'Jal Shakti Abhiyan' (18th April 2022)


#### Report on Yoga Week 2022 "Yoga for Humanity"




The energetic session had culminated with a vote of thanks given by our Joint secretory Mr. Neeraj Kumar to our Speaker.




