The recommendations of the Selection Committee/ Screening-cum-Evaluation Committee constituted to consider the grant of higher APL to the teachers under Career Advancement Scheme in the Deptt of Electrical Engg, Physics and Civil Engg held on 03.11.2025 & 06.11.2025 were placed before the Council in sealed envelopes. The sealed envelopes were opened before the house.

The matter in respect of recommended Date of Promotion in the cases of reassessment of Dr M K Yadav and Dr Shakuntala was discussed in detail.

Prof Rajive Kumar, Vice Chancellor of this University, briefed the house that in the cases of reassessment, the date of promotion has been given as, one year after the original date of eligibility of respective candidates.

Prof Dinesh Kumar, Vice Chancellor SVSU mentioned that the benefits of the promotion under CAS should be given as per the rules of the State Govt. Dr Pratap Singh, Nominee of DGTE and Prof Bhola Ram Gurjar, Director NITTTR also endorsed and agreed to the opinion of Prof Dinesh Kumar.

Sh K P Singh, Joint Director, DTE, Nominee of ACS Technical Education opined that the cases of reassessment may be sent to the State Govt for clarification.

Prof Rajive Kumar gave a detailed justification stating that in the following clause of UGC Regulations 2018 conveyed by the State Govt, the actual meaning of the Date of Rejection needs to be understood in true spirit.

*The candidate who does not succeed in the first assessment, He/She shall have to be reassessed only after one year. When a candidate succeeds in the eventual assessment, his/her promotion shall be deemed to be one year from the date of rejection.*

In above clause, the Date of Rejection is not to be interpreted as the Date on which the candidate got rejected on assessment date. The actual intent of the Date of Rejection is the Date of eligibility itself. Since in case, the candidate is successful and recommended by the Selection Committee, he is granted benefits from the original date of eligibility; similarly, in case of rejection, the candidate stands rejected w.e.f the original date of eligibility therefore the original date of eligibility is deemed to be the date of rejection. Therefore one year after the date of rejection is to be interpreted as one year after the date of eligibility. Prof Rajive Kumar further emphasized that the Selection Committee has given the recommendations by interpreting the applicable rules of the State Govt only. He further stated that this matter needs not be sent to the State Govt for any clarification as there is no confusion and the reassessment has been done under very much clarity of the applicable rules. He also stated that he is under information that Universities under the ambit of Higher Education/Technical Education like Kurukshetra University, DCRUST Murthal and Delhi University have also considered the reassessment cases, following the same pattern, by granting the benefits w.e.f one year after the date of eligibility. The said cases have been approved by the State Govt and the same should not be doubted for, in the case of this University, to ensure uniformity of rules across all sister Universities. He also added that the Executive Council of this University in 48<sup>th</sup> meeting with consent of all members (except nominee of ACS TE & DGTE) has also already approved the report of the Committee which had recommended that the Date of promotion in cases of reassessment may be considered as one year after the original date of eligibility. He strongly asserted that the matter should be looked into keeping in mind the wise judgement rather than sticking to literal meaning of terms.

Prof Tankeshwar Kumar, Vice Chancellor Central University of Haryana, agreed to the opinion of Prof Rajive Kumar and further added that the date of eligibility of the candidate is after the completion of the assessment period and the work of the candidate is assessed only upto the assessment period i.e upto the Date of Eligibility. Since in case of successful assessment, the date of eligibility is considered as the date of promotion; In the same manner, the Date of Rejection is to be considered as the Date of Eligibility. The promotion or rejection both will be effective w.e.f the same date i.e. Date of Eligibility.

Prof Brij Kishore Kuthiala opined that the Executive Council is the prime deciding body of the University and the Nominee of the State Govt is a member of the same. The matter if approved by the majority of the members stand approved by the Executive Council and needs not be referred to the State Govt, in order to avoid further delay and loss to the candidates.

All other members of the Executive Council agreed upon the opinions of Prof Rajive Kumar and Prof Tankeshwar Kumar.

On the overall recommendations of members of the Executive Council, the recommendations of the respective Selection Committees and Screening-cum-Evaluation Committees were approved by the Executive Council.

The Chairman briefed the house about the representations of teachers.

Prof Tankeshwar Kumar said that the said agenda item may be put up in the next meeting of the Executive Council with full details, like assessment period, eligibility etc so as to further comment on the issue.

Sh K P Singh, Joint Director, DTE, Nominee of ACS Technical Education opined that the said agenda may be deferred this time and to be placed in next EC with full details.

After detailed deliberations, it was resolved to defer the agenda this time and place the same with full details in the next meeting of the Executive Council.
