Short description of Activity (Max 100 words)

In response to the urgent need for environmental conservation and climate change mitigation, J.C. Bose University of Science and Technology, YMCA, Faridabad, today initiated Plantation Drive-2023 "Hariyali Parv" with "Ek Paudha Ek Sankalp". "Hariyali Parv" is a plantation campaign conducted by the Vasundhara Eco-club of the University in collaboration with the Dean Student Welfare office and Department of Environmental Sciences.

The campaign was inaugurated by Chief Guest Mr. S.S. Banga, CMD Victoria Industries Pvt. Ltd, presided over by Vice-Chancellor, J.C Bose University, Prof. S.K. Tomar by planting the saplings of Neem plants in University campus. Atma Ram and other organizing committee members were present at the inauguration ceremony.
