## **Detailed Activity Report**

VasundharaEco-Club in collaboration with Department of Environmental Sciences, J.C Bose University of Sciences and Technology, YMCA Faridabad organised a Poster making competition on the theme My Waste My Responsibility on 07th November, 2023. The objective of the program was to sensitize the students and staff members about the illeffect of improper disposal of waste in our surroundings and inculcating a feeling of responsibility to manage their own waste. The competition was an extraordinary way for the young youth artists to hone their skills, foster passion and confidence to represent various solutions related to waste management.

Participants were divided into three age-groups and were mainly the university students and children of staff members. The Chairperson/Incharge, Department of Environmental Sciences and Vasundhara-Eco Club, Dr.Renuka Gupta informed that Vasundhara Eco-club has initiated an awareness campaign on My Waste My Responsibility to sensitize the 3Ss – students, staff and society. The poster making competition is the first activity under this campaign. She apprised that significant sensitization of stakeholders about segregation of waste at source and its proper disposal can only be solution to reduce the waste going to landfills. About 105 students and children participated in the event. The jury members included Dr.Anuradha Pillai, Associate Professor, Computer Engineering, Dr. Kakoli Dutt, Associate Professor, Life Sciences and Sh. Prem Bajpai, University Librarian. Various senior faculty members visited the event and encouraged the participants.

In the age category of 6-10yrs, the first prize was achieved by Maanya, second position was taken by Anvika Sheokand and the third position got tied between Raghav and Anaya Rawat. Similarly, in the category of 11-15yrs, Havi Bhatia got the first prize, Tanishka Sheokand got the second position, Anusha was awarded for third position. In the category of 15yrs and above, the first prize went to Jyothi Raj (MBA), the second prize was given to Bidhya Singh (MSc EVS 1st Semester) and the third position was won by Bhawna Chauhan (MSc EVS 3rd Semester). The Eco-club members Dr. Anita Girdhar, Dr. Sakshi Kalra and Dr. Preeti Sethi were also present on the occasion. The event was successfully organised by the student team lead by Jyoti, Aashirwad, Tushar, Urvashi, Juhi, Riya, Bharat, Rahul, Rudraksh, Navya and other members.
