4. Submit the hard copy of the application along with all supporting documents to the **Scholarship Branch (DSW Office)** on any working day.

Important Instructions

- These applications are **only for the Academic Session 2025-26**.
- Scholarship will be released only to those students whose **Savings Bank Account is Aadhaar-mapped**.
- Students must mention **only the Aadhaar-mapped Savings Bank Account Number** in the application form.
- Students are also required to submit a copy of the Aadhaar Bank Mapping status, which can be obtained from:

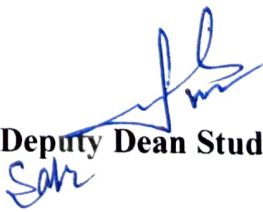
