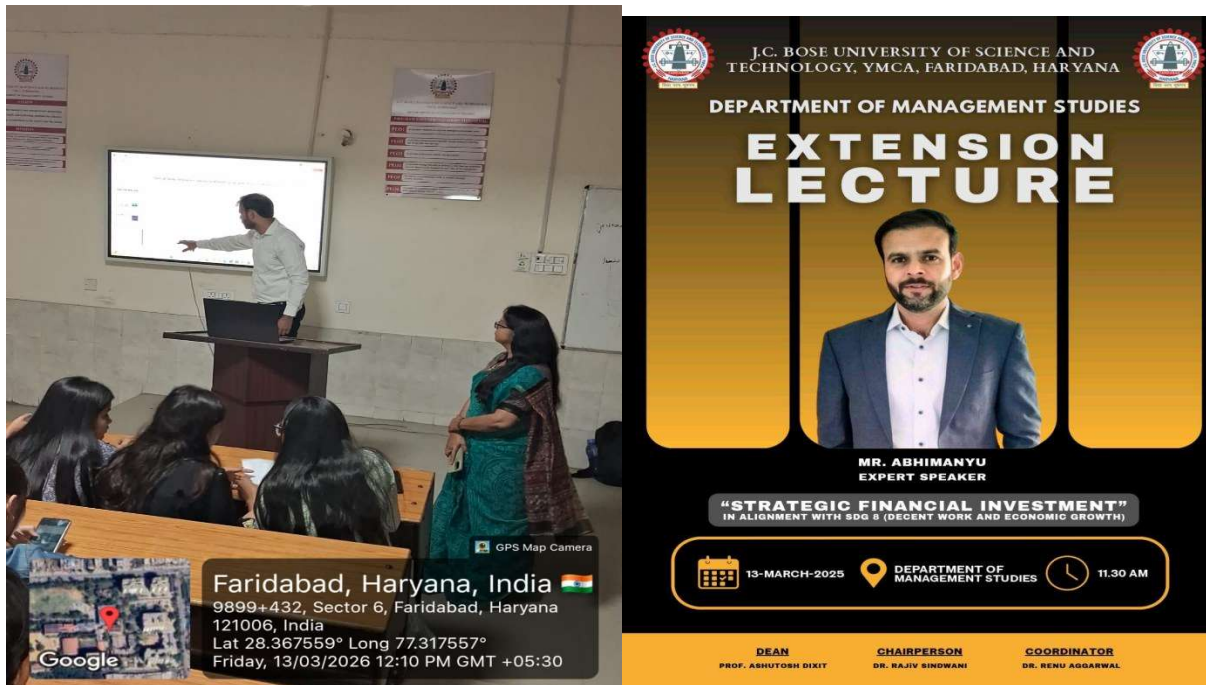


Report on Extension Lecture on “Strategic Financial Investments” 13th March 2026



The Department of Management Studies organized an expert lecture on “Strategic Financial Investment” in Alignment with SDG 8: Decent Work and Economic Growth on 13 March 2026 at 11:30 AM. The session was organized by the Faculty Coordinator **Dr. Renu Aggarwal** under the guidance of the dean **Prof. Ashutosh Dixit** and the chairperson **Dr. Rajiv Sindwani** of the department.

The resource person for the lecture was Mr. Abhimanyu, who brings over 15 years of industry experience, including more than 9 years with Fidelity.

The session focused on Sustainable Development Goal (SDG 8), which emphasizes decent work and sustainable economic growth. During the lecture, the speaker discussed both financial and non-financial aspects of strategic investment. He elaborated on the strategic investment model and clarified several myths and facts related to market share and investment strategies.
