Subject: Online submission of applications for Scholarship Schemes available on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) for the Academic Session 2026-27.

It is hereby informed to all concerned students of J.C. Bose University of Science and Technology, YMCA, Faridabad that the **National Scholarship Portal (NSP)** has been opened for the **Academic Session 2026-27**. The portal is available for eligible students to apply for various Central Sector and Welfare-Based Scholarship Schemes as per the eligibility conditions prescribed by the concerned Ministry/Department.

The students of all courses who are eligible for any scholarship scheme available on NSP (**except SC & BC students who are residents of Haryana, who are covered under the concerned Haryana State scholarship process**) are advised to apply online through the official National Scholarship Portal within the prescribed time.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

1. **One Time Registration (OTR) is mandatory** for applying for scholarships on NSP. OTR is a unique number allotted to the student and remains applicable throughout the student's academic career.
2. Students should first complete their **OTR registration** and thereafter log in through their OTR ID and password to submit the scholarship application.
3. Students must carefully check the **eligibility criteria, scholarship guidelines, required documents and scheme-specific conditions** before applying.
4. NSP currently permits students, subject to scheme eligibility, to apply for **one merit-based scholarship scheme and one or more welfare-based scholarship schemes** from Academic Year 2026-27.
5. Students should fill in all details carefully and upload the required documents in the prescribed format.
6. After successful online submission, students must **take a printout of the submitted application form** along with all the documents/annexures uploaded on the portal.
7. The printed application form along with the required supporting documents should be kept safely by the student and **submitted in hard copy in the Scholarship Branch, DSW Office, on any working day** for institutional processing/verification, wherever required.

8. **The last date for student application for major NSP schemes currently open is 31.10.2026.** However, students must check the closing date of their particular scholarship scheme on the NSP portal, as different schemes may have different timelines.
9. Students must ensure that the **bank account furnished in the scholarship application is linked/seeded with Aadhaar for DBT**, wherever required under the concerned scheme. Students are advised to verify their Aadhaar-bank seeding status before submitting the application.
10. Students should ensure that the **name, date of birth, Aadhaar details, bank account details and other particulars** entered in the scholarship application are correct and match the relevant official records.

SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES

The NSP provides scholarships under various Ministries/Departments. Depending upon eligibility, students may find schemes such as:

- **PM-USP – Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students (CSSS)**
- **AICTE Scholarship Schemes (Pragati/ Swanath/Saksham)**, including eligible technical degree schemes
- **Central Sector Scheme of Top Class Education for SC Students**
- **Post-Matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities**
- **Scholarship for Top Class Education for Students with Disabilities**
- **PM YASASVI – Top Class Education for OBC, EBC & DNT Students**
- **Prime Minister's Scholarship Schemes**
- **Scholarships/Fellowships under UGC and other Central Ministries/Departments**
- Other schemes available on NSP as per the student's eligibility.

Note: Availability of a scheme does **not** mean automatic eligibility. Students must check the detailed eligibility conditions, income/merit/category/course/institution requirements and other conditions applicable to the particular scheme before applying.
