As instructions received from NEP Cell, APAAR IDs are to be generated for all the students admitted during the academic session 2021-22 and onwards. As part of the transformative vision for the Indian education system, University has introduced the Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry (APAAR) ID for all students admitted during the session 2021-2022 and onwards. The APAAR ID embodies the vision of "One Nation, One Student ID," ensuring a unified and accessible academic experience for students across India. This lifelong academic passport consolidates all achievements and credentials of a student in one place.

APAAR assigns a unique and permanent 12-digit ID to every student, offering a comprehensive record of their academic achievements, including degrees, scholarships, awards, and other credits. This identifier remains with the student throughout their educational career, fostering a seamless transition from one level of education to another.

Benefits to Students:

1. **Unified Academic Identity:** A single platform to consolidate and showcase academic records.
2. **Streamlined Student Records:** Simplifies record-keeping for students, parents, and educators.
3. **Digital Repository:** Securely stores academic data and achievements.

Steps to Generate APAAR ID:

1. Visit <https://digilocker.meriphechaan.gov.in/> and sign up / log in to your account.
2. On the dashboard, navigate to the "Search Documents" section.
3. Enter "Academic Bank of Credits" in the search bar.
4. Click on the "Academic Bank of Credits." Within this section, you will find the APAAR ID. Fill in the required details and click on "Get Document" to generate your APAAR ID.
5. Upon successful completion, your APAAR ID will be generated and available in the "Issued Documents" section.

It is imperative that every student generates APAAR ID to comply with the requirements of NEP 2020 for academic mobility.

Accordingly, all Directors/Principals of affiliated institutions/ Chairpersons of UTDs and Principal CCSD are requested to impress upon their students admitted during 2021-22 and onwards to open Digi-locker account and APAAR account and supply the list of APAAR IDs as per the attached excel format latest by 16th August, 2024 for students admitted from 2021-22 and onwards.
