  - (3) The schedule for conduct of extra-curricular activities will be issued by the DSW without affecting the teaching hours of the students during the above period.
  - (4) Students Feedback by concerned Chairperson-UTDs / Principal of Affiliated Institutions: - after six weeks from the starting of classes, The Reports of Student Feed Back & Academic Audit will be submitted to Director, IQAC by the concerned Chairperson within ten days of conduct, after analysis and action taken. Notice for Academic Audit will be issued by Director-IQAC.
  - (5) Registration is mandatory for all students (to be ensured by Affiliation & Registration Branch).
  - (6) If the number of teaching days falls less than 180 days (90 days in each semester) during AY 2023-24 due to some unforeseen reasons, it shall be the responsibility of every teacher to make good the loss, by taking extra classes.
  - (7) Display of list of students having attendance less than (<75%) by the Chairperson of UTD's / Director-Principal of affiliated Institution: - Last week of every month. Intimation regarding students having shortage of attendance less than (<75%) to the parents by concerned Chairpersons of UTD / Principal of Affiliated Institution: - Every last week of the month from starting of classes.
  - (8) Submission of detained students list to Academic Branch by the respective UTDs: - last working day of classes (before starting of Practical/Theory exams) all Chairpersons / Principals are requested kindly not allow to any student for appearing in the Practical/Theory Examination who having attendances less than 75% without condoned by the authority.
  - (9) The schedule for conduct of Induction / Orientation Programme will be issued by Office of the Dean Student Welfare for UTD's or the Director-Principals of affiliated Institutions under intimation to this office
