**SCHEDULE & INSTRUCTIONS FOR OPEN COUNSELING OF B.TECH. & B.TECH-LEET
(for AIC Category -without any reservation &
Supernumerary Seats-EWS,TFW,KM)**

With reference to the Notice issued vide No.Acad./10/07/2024/1668 dated 01.10.2024, the **Open Counseling** against leftover/vacant seats for **B.Tech/ B.Tech LEET** programs running under the UTDs of J.C. Bose University of Science and Technology, YMCA, Faridabad, will be conducted for candidates, **(who have applied in respect of notice mentioned above in the University and their name available in the New Merit List)** as per the following schedule:

Venue for Reporting for Counseling: All candidates shall report to **Shakuntalam Hall** at the University. After reporting, they will proceed to have their certificates verified by the document verification committees, located at Shri Krishna Bhawan, (Cafeteria Building), near the University Main Gate.

Eligibility Criteria: As per the HSTES Admission Prospectus 2024-25 and the University Information Brochure 2024-25. For further details, please refer to the AICTE APH 2024-27.

Important Instructions:

1. Institute-Level (Physical) **Open Counseling** shall be conducted for vacant/Left Over seats as per the seat matrix of vacant/unfilled seats already notified on the university website, based on JEE Main 2024 CRL Rank **(for B.Tech)** and based on Intra-se-merit/percentage of qualifying exam **(for B.Tech LEET)** . The counseling will follow the information and instructions mentioned in the concerned B.Tech/B.Tech LEET Admission Brochure 2024 of HSTES.

2. This Open Counseling shall be conducted for **AIC** category (**Without any reservation**), and all supernumerary seats (**KM/TFW/EWS**) based on HSTES guidelines.
3. The counseling will be conducted according to the merit list, already displayed on the university website for the concerned program. **This counseling shall be only for candidates, who have applied through fresh application physically in the University as per the notice mentioned above and their name available in the New Merit List.**
4. The vacant seat positions are purely tentative and may change at the time of actual counseling due to admission cancellation requests by admitted candidates. **Candidates are advised to regularly visit the University's website (www.jcboseust.ac.in) for category-wise updates on vacant seat status and to report accordingly for admission.**
5. Candidates must attend the counseling in person and be present before the committee at the time of seat allotment. **Physical attendance is mandatory.** If a candidate reports late for document verification during counseling, he/she will be considered only for the available seats at that time, following the verification of documents.
6. **The candidates are advised to check the Vacancy Position carefully before reporting for Counseling, which is available on the University Website.**
7. Before reporting, candidates must ensure they have all relevant documents as per the category claimed for admission. All documents should be arranged in order (two sets) and self-attested. Original documents will be required at the time of manual/Institute-level counseling for verification, but **the original certificates will not be retained.**
8. The eligibility of the candidate for admission in a particular category is subject to verification and submission of the required documents at the time of admission.
9. It is mandatory for the candidate to pay the requisite fee at the time of admission; otherwise, their admission will not be confirmed. **However no fee should be charged from Schedule Caste candidates who are eligible under the Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for SC students except security amount i.e. Rs.7000/- (Refundable).** Following is the 1st Semester Fee for B. Tach./ 3rd Semester Fee for B.Tech LEET Programs:

10. Fees can be deposited in the form of a Demand Draft drawn in favor of 'Registrar, J.C. Bose UST, YMCA Faridabad' at the time of seat allotment for admission. Payment can also be made via **Debit/Credit card**, subject to applicable charges. **Cash payments will not be accepted under any circumstances.**
11. **Candidates already admitted** to J.C. Bose University through the **1st or 2nd online counseling by HSTES and via 1st, 2nd Institute Level Physical Counseling/ Open Counseling**, must mandatorily produce a copy of the admission slip downloaded from the HSTES website and Admission Letter.

12. For admissions under the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category, candidates must mandatorily provide an EWS Income & Asset Certificate indicating an income below Rs. 6 lakh, issued by the Competent Authority of Haryana State only. Additionally, a Resident/Domicile Certificate of Haryana is required to avail of the benefits of the EWS category if the candidate completed their last qualifying exam in another state. The family income of the candidate will be matched and verified using their PPP ID. In the event that no eligible students are available in this category, the seat shall not be allotted to candidates from any other category
13. For admissions under the Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) category, candidates must provide an Income Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Haryana State, stating an **income does not exceed Rs.8 lakh from all sources**, verified through their PPP ID. Additionally, a Resident/Domicile Certificate of Haryana is mandatory to avail of the benefits of the TFW category if the candidate completed their last qualifying exam in another state. Candidates admitted under this category shall not be allowed to change the institution or program under any circumstances. In the event that no eligible students are available in this category, the seat shall not be allotted to candidates from any other category.
14. The candidate applying under the Kashmiri Migrant (KM) category must ensure that they possess a Kashmiri Migrant (KM) Certificate issued by the competent authority or the Relief Commissioner.
15. In case any grievance arises during admission/counseling, the matter shall be addressed by the Dean Academic Affairs. If the issue is not resolved, it shall be forwarded, to the University's Admission Grievance Committee (as notified in Number 2024/Acad./1205 dated 02.07.2024) through the Academic Branch, with a written representation submitted through the proper channel.

17. Before Admission seat allotment, candidate shall get his/her earlier admission in other institute, if any, cancelled from previously allotted institute. If candidate is facing any problem in getting the seat cancelled from previously allotted institute , he/she may contact HSTES for cancellation of previously allotted seat, (If required) on Toll Free Number 1800-137-3735 and email id onlineadmissionhelp@gmail.com
