**Subject : Regarding date extension of online submission of applications for National Scholarship Portal Schemes for all Students (except SC&BC resident of Haryana who apply for the Post Matric Scholarship on the portal of Haryana Govt.) for the session 2020-21 & Mapped the Aadhar Card with Student's Saving Bank Account No.**

It is to inform all concerned Students of 1<sup>st</sup> year & 2<sup>nd</sup> Year (LEET), who are studying in this University that the concerned department of National Scholarship Portal has issued a Notification that all the scholarship applications for National Scholarship Portal Schemes students for the Session 2022-23 should be applied through scholarship portal running by the department under NSP Plan, i.e. <https://scholarships.gov.in/home>.

So, all the concerned students of all courses (except SC&BC resident of Haryana who apply for the Post Matric Scholarship on the portal of Haryana Govt.) are advised to submit online applications on the portal: <https://scholarships.gov.in/home> & take a printout of the same. After taking printout of online submitted form along with all the annexures, which are uploaded online while submitting the application form, keep it themselves carefully and submit the hard copy of the same to the Academic Section on any working day. Please note the last date of applying the scholarship form is **30.11.2022** instead of **31.10.2022**. Please note that these application forms are for the session 2022-23. Only those students will be granted scholarship who's Saving Bank A/c No. "Mapped" with their Aadhar No. So, all Students are directed to mention only that Saving Bank Account No. in the application form that is mapped with their Aadhar Card & submit the copy of the same after getting the printout from the website, i.e. <https://resident.uidai.gov.in/bank-mapper> to Academic Section along with application form.
