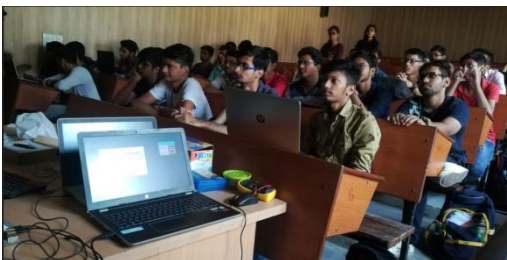
# SAMARPAN THE TECHNOPHILIA

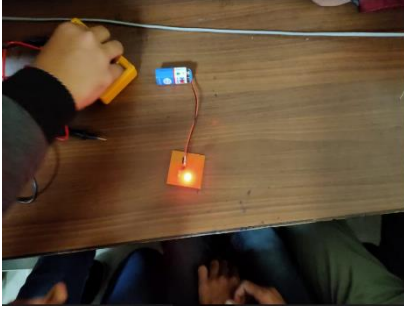

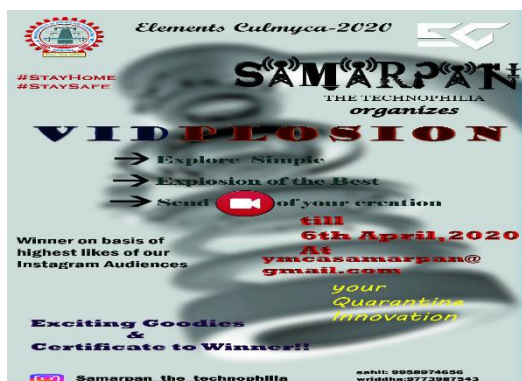

## Event 11 : UI DESIGNING AND ROBOTICS

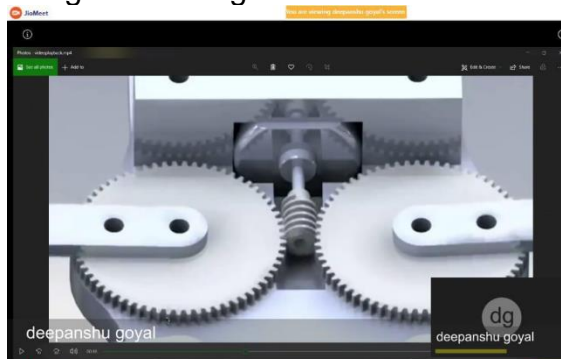

### DATE OF EVENT: 3 JULY'20

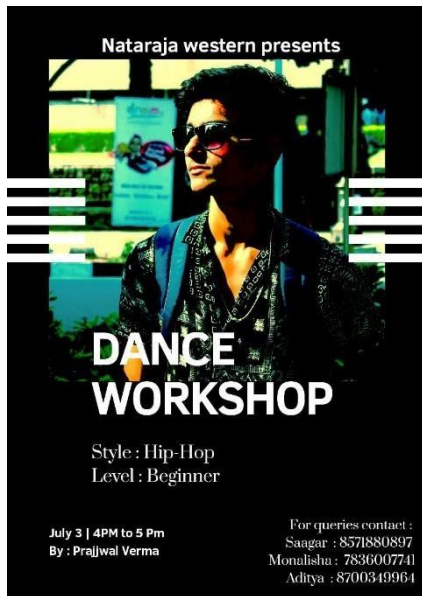

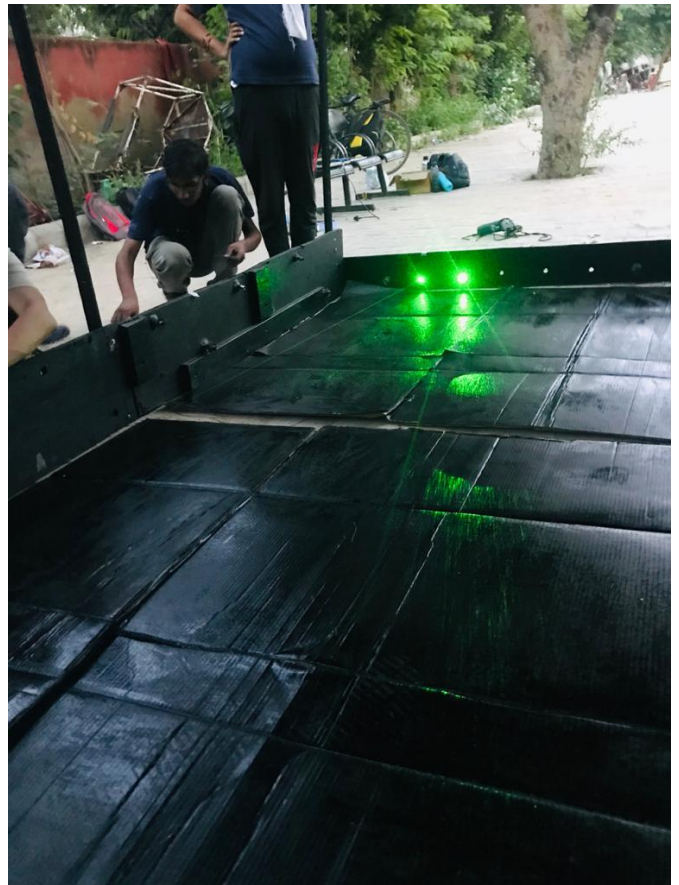

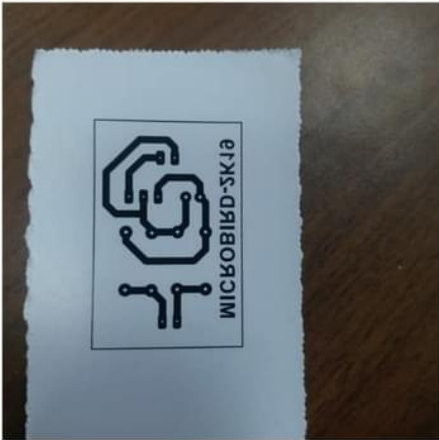


## Event 3: PCB Designing Workshop

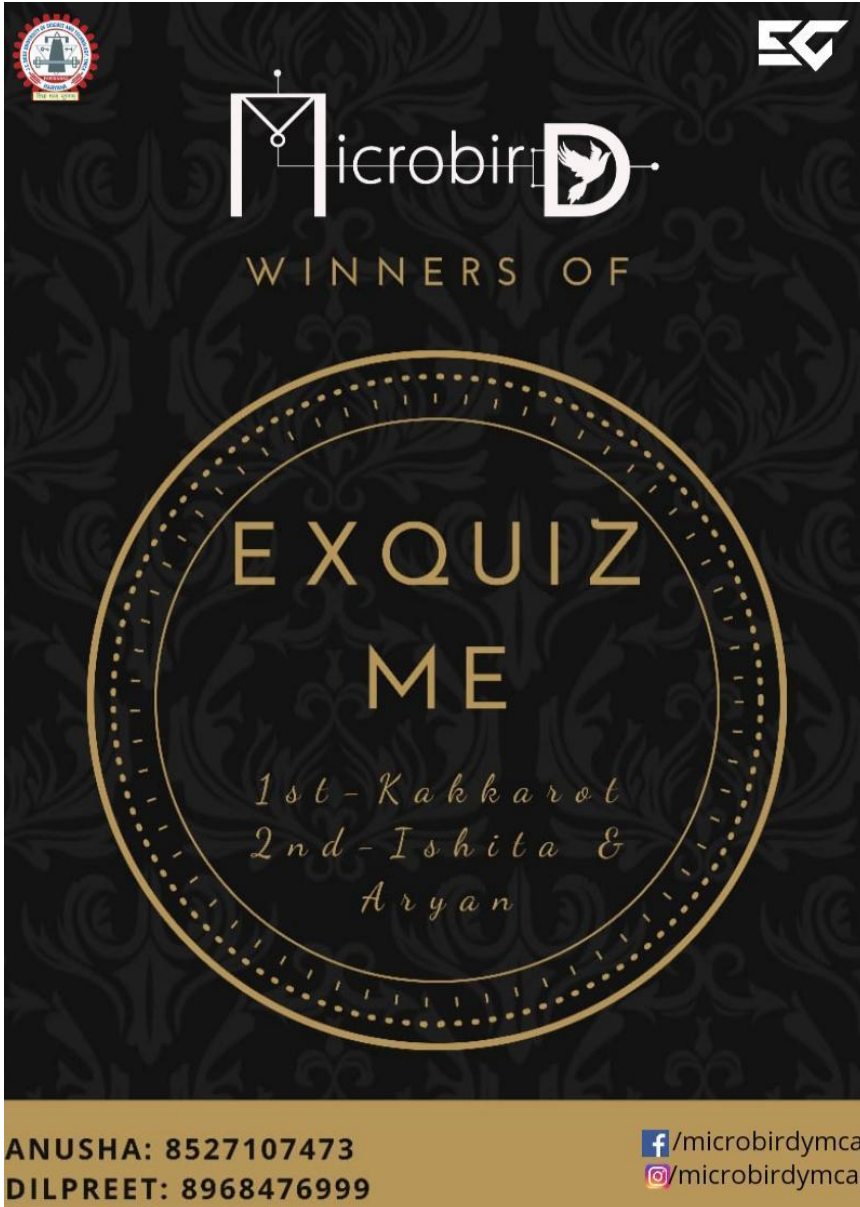

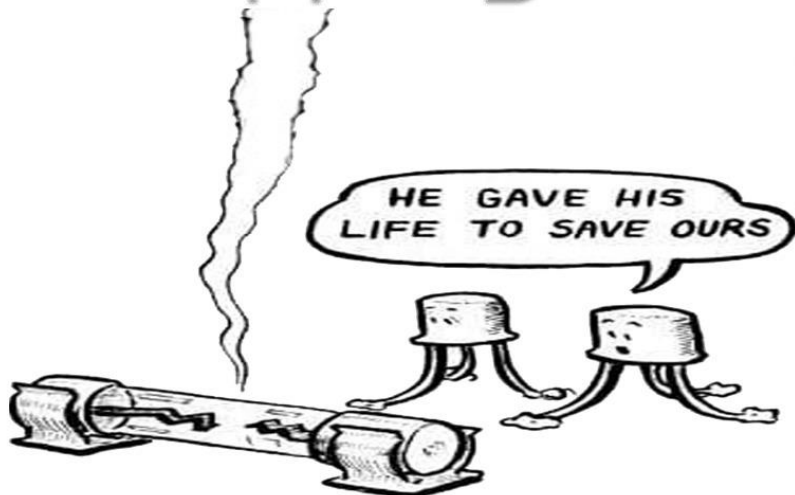

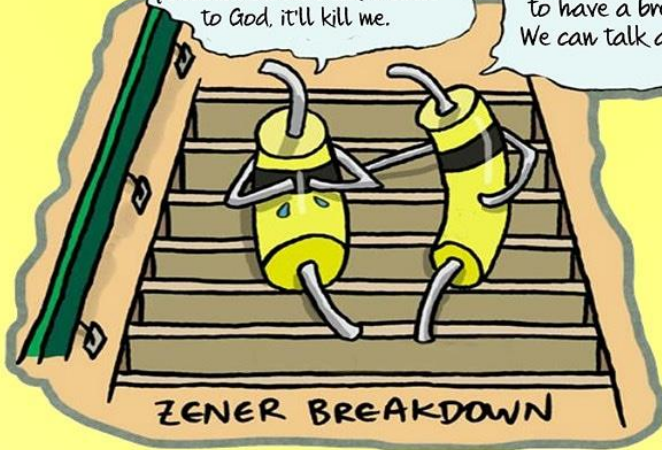

This workshop is conducted on an online platform which is coordinated by Shubham Kamboj.

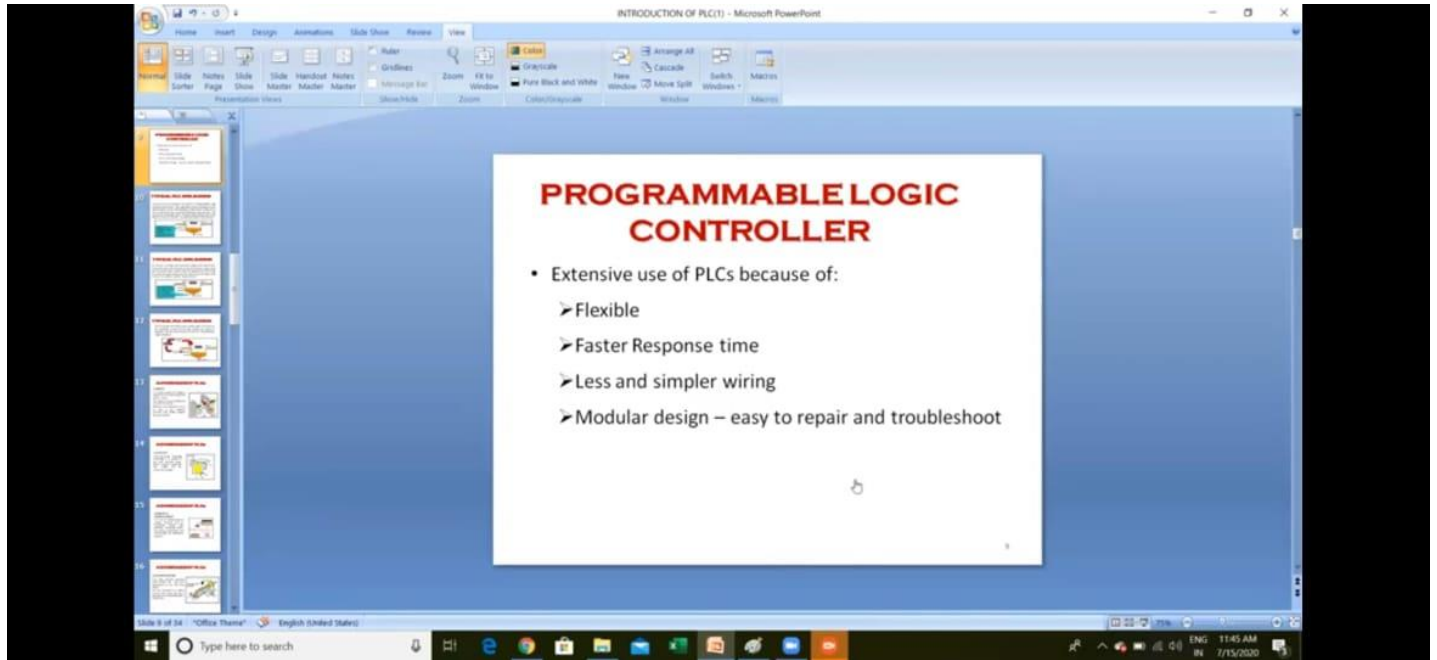

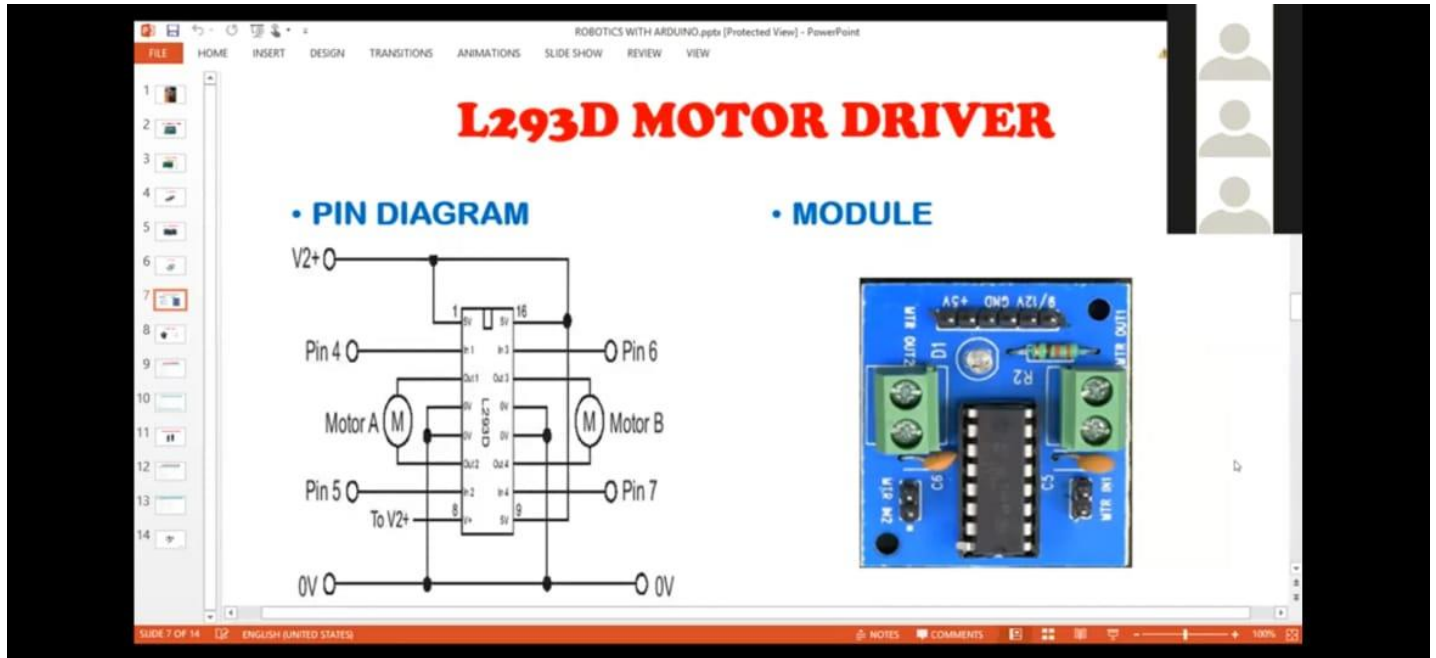
## Event 7: Robotics with Arduino

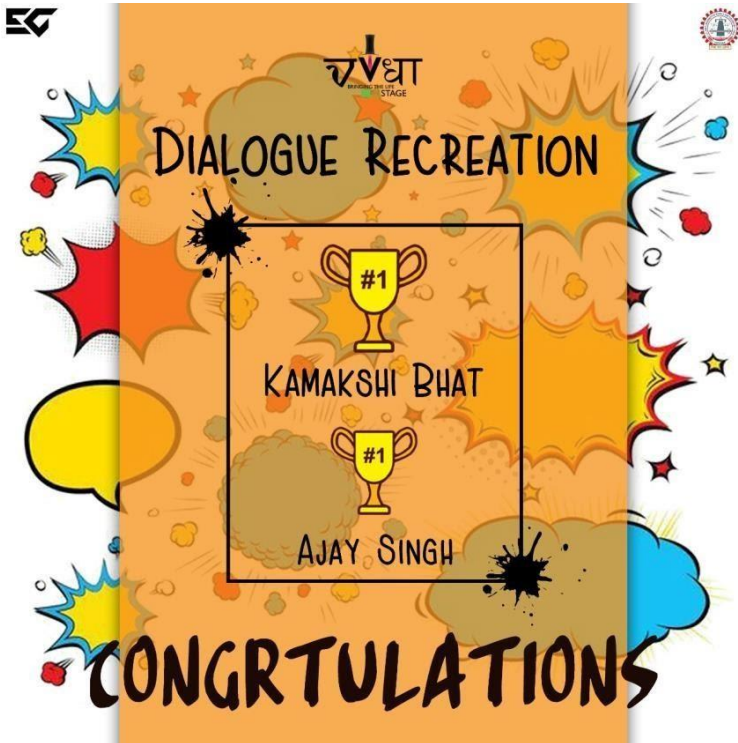

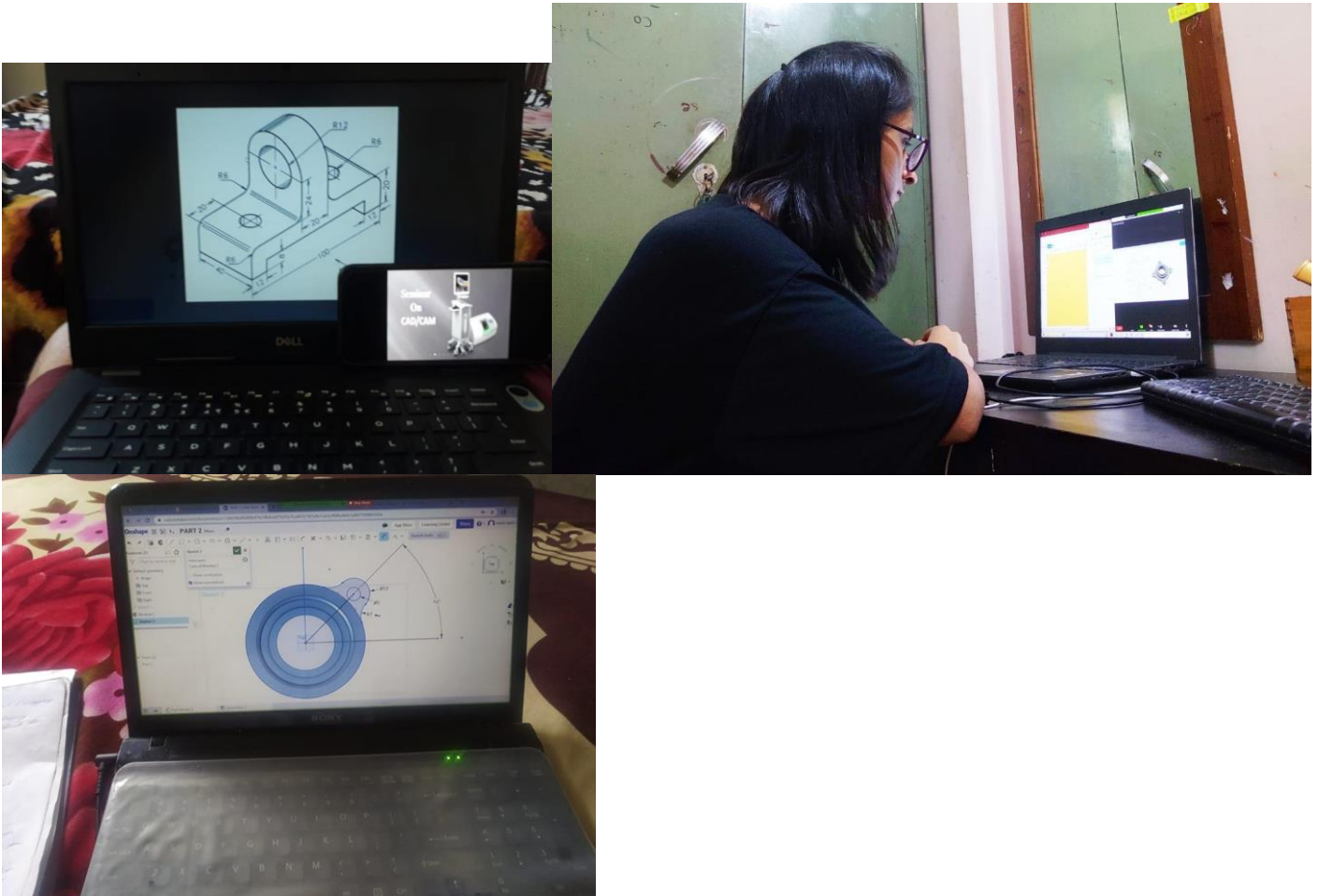

structures. This workshop will help you to know feasibility, properties like stress , force holding capacity of your design.



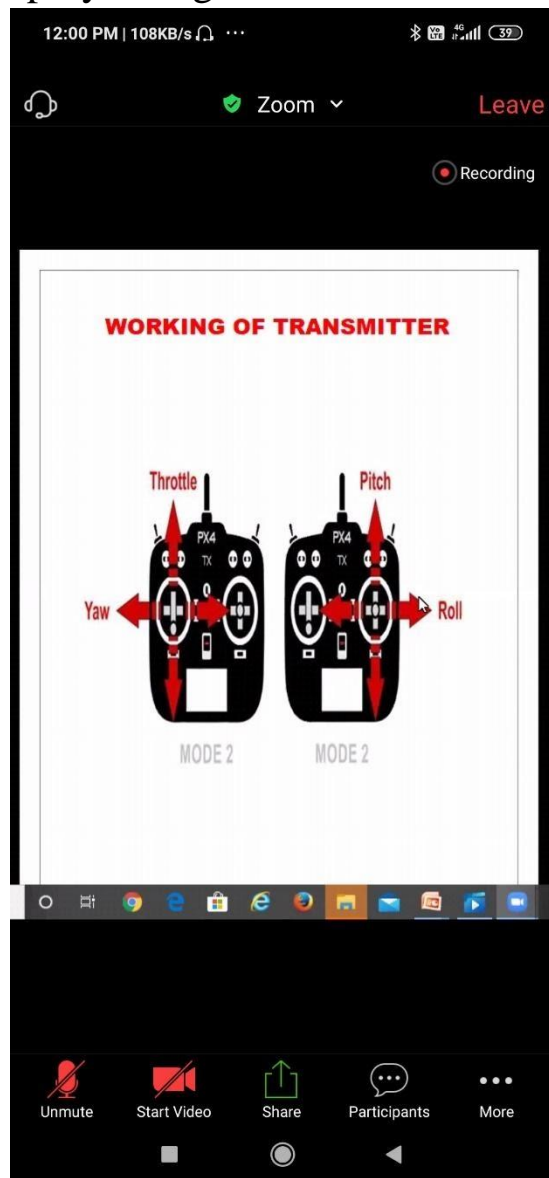
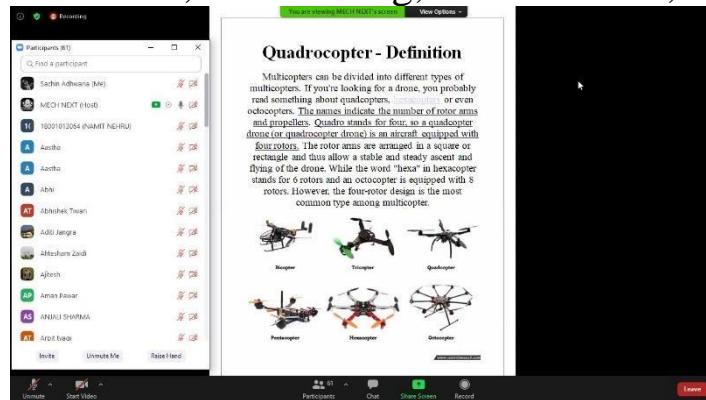



National flag was hoisted by our honourable Vice Chancellor Dr. Dinesh Aggarwal. Students listened to the Independence Day message given by VC Sir.

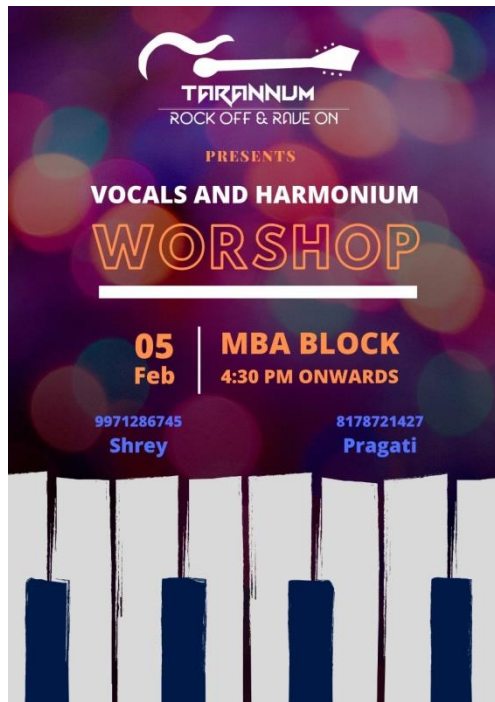
Around 30 members were there in this group song.

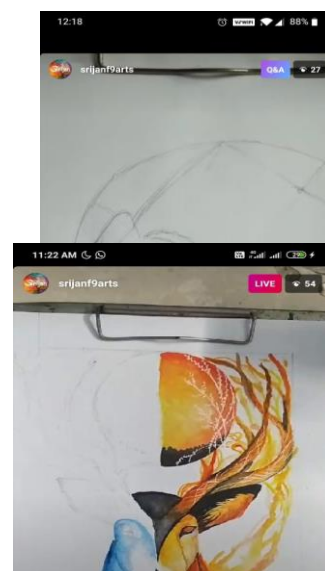
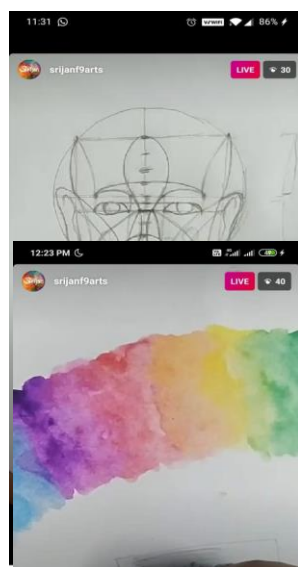
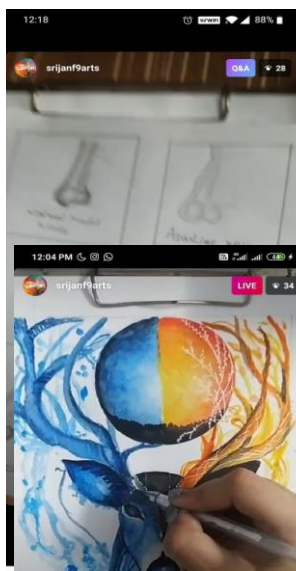
#### Day -2 Painting and art tool making

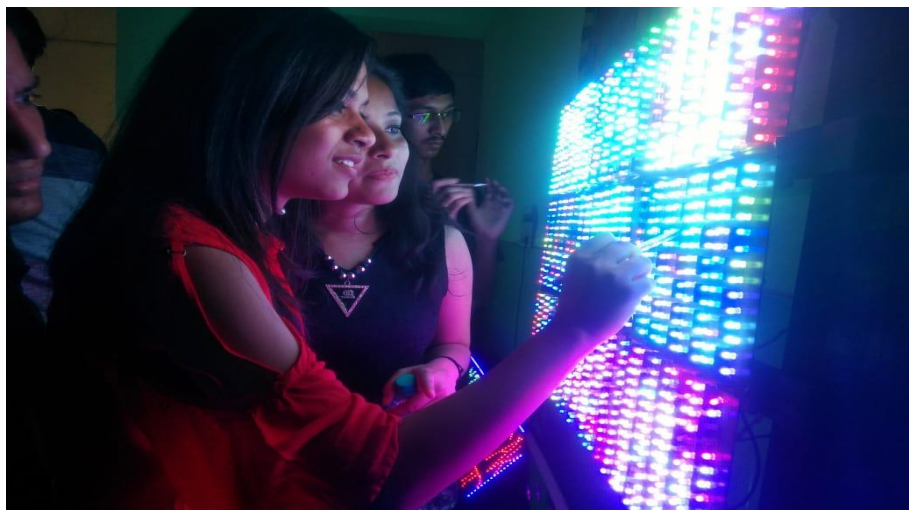



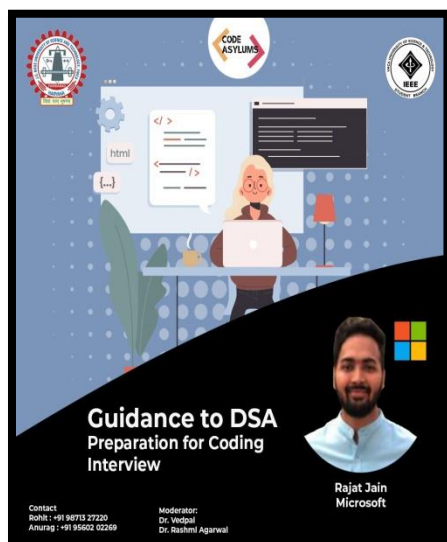
## **Event 22: GUIDANCE TO DSA**

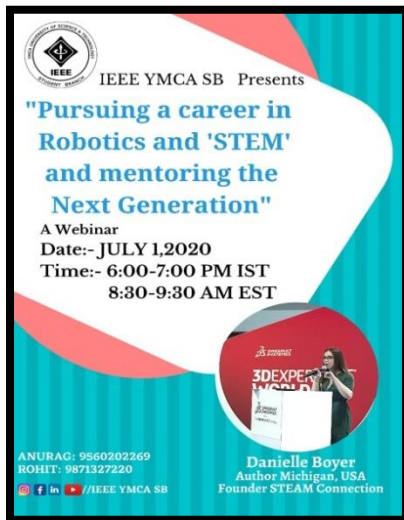

Aiming to provide an intense training on teaching basics of Data Science at undergraduate level for college students, a two-day online workshop on 'Introduction to Data Science' held during

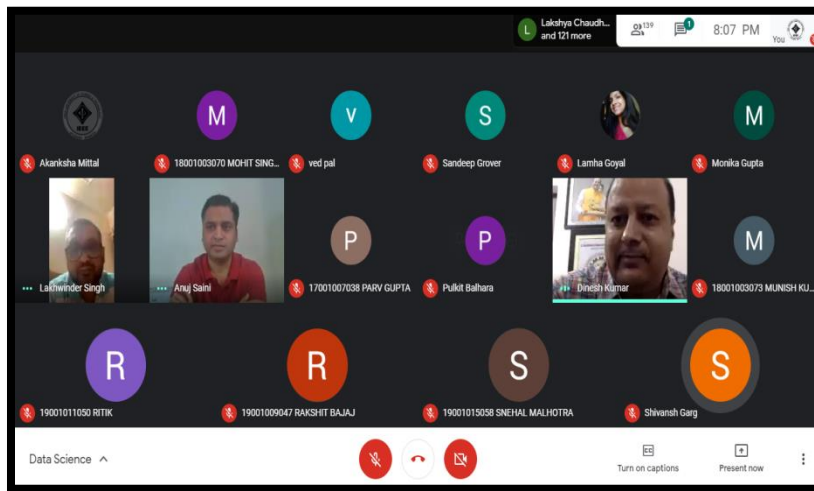



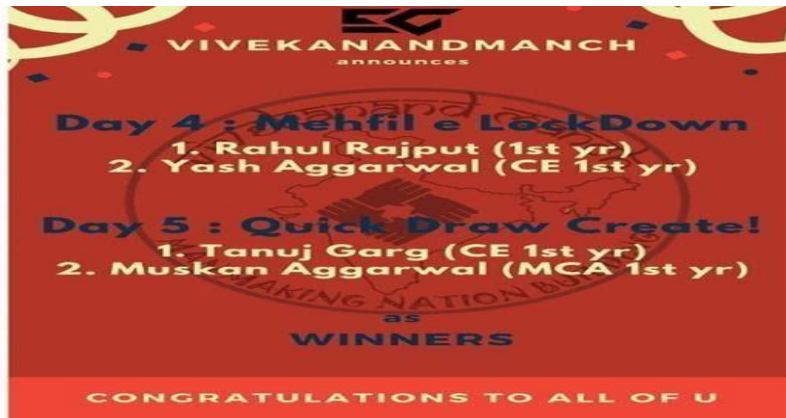


## 4. MEHFIL-E-LOCKDOWN

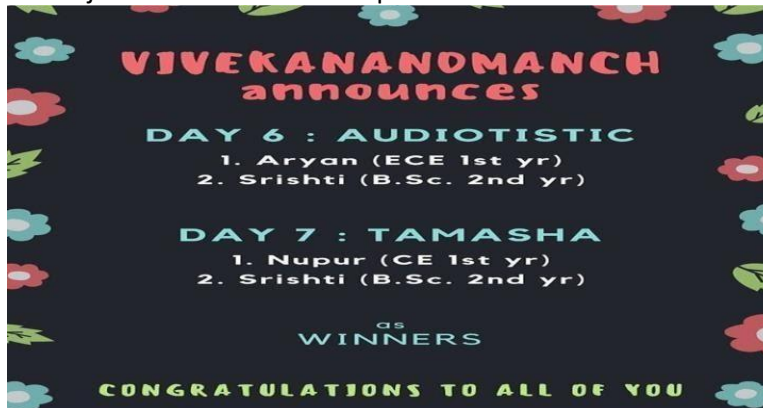


## 6. AUDIOTISTIC

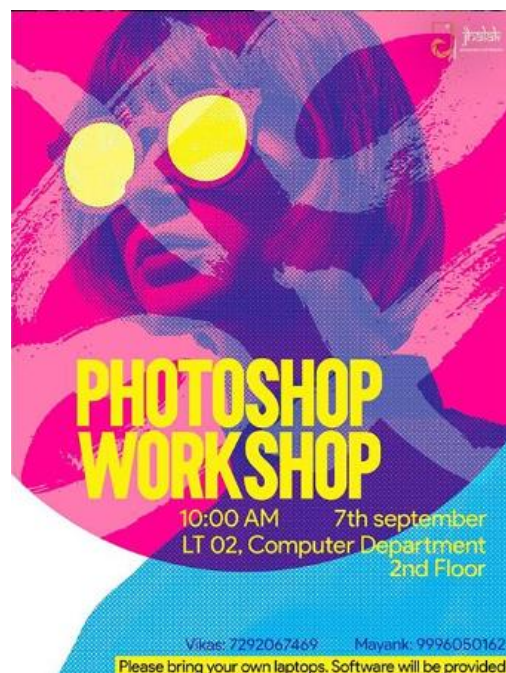




## Photoshop Workshop

### THE B-ROLL CHALLENGE



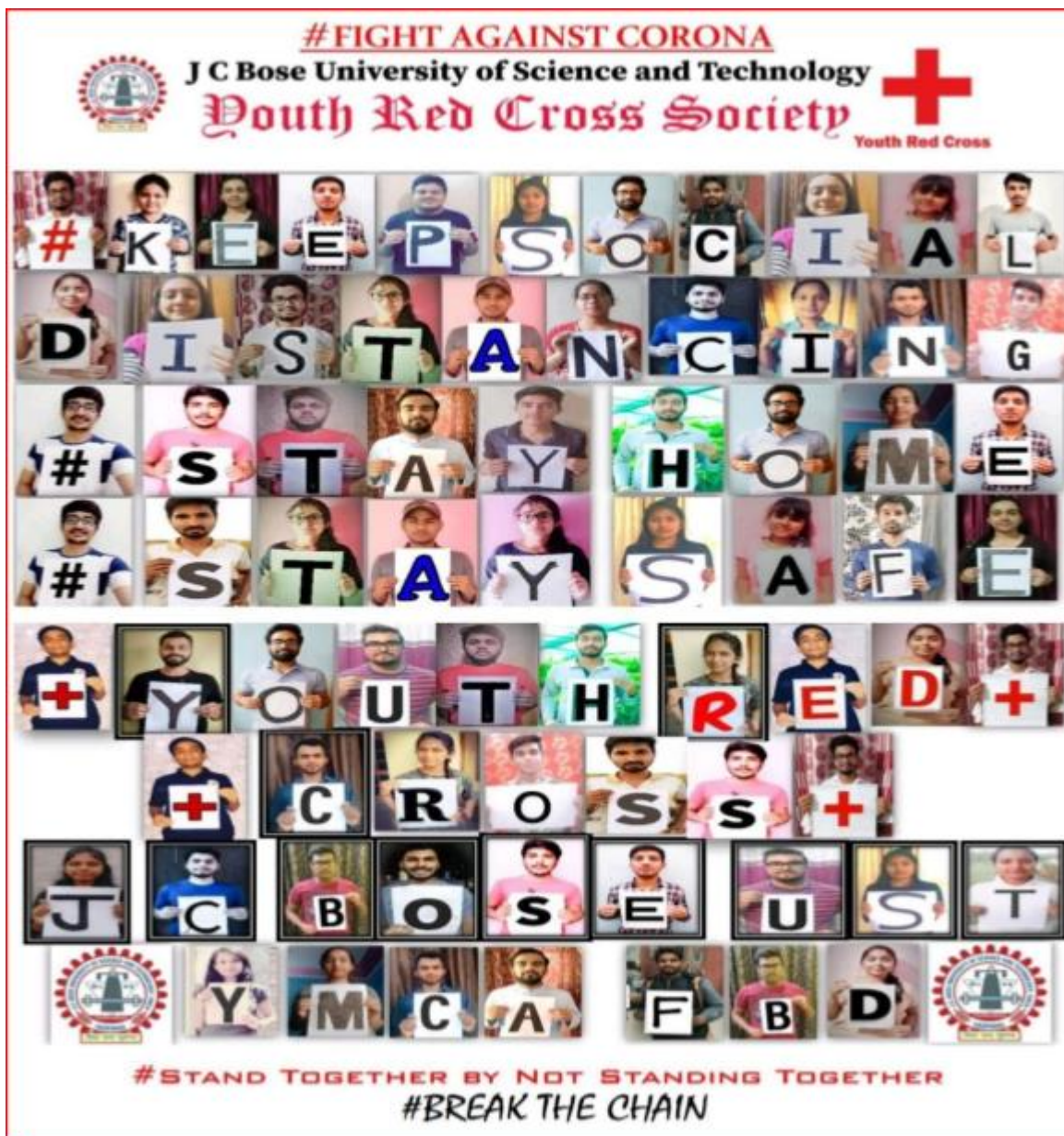

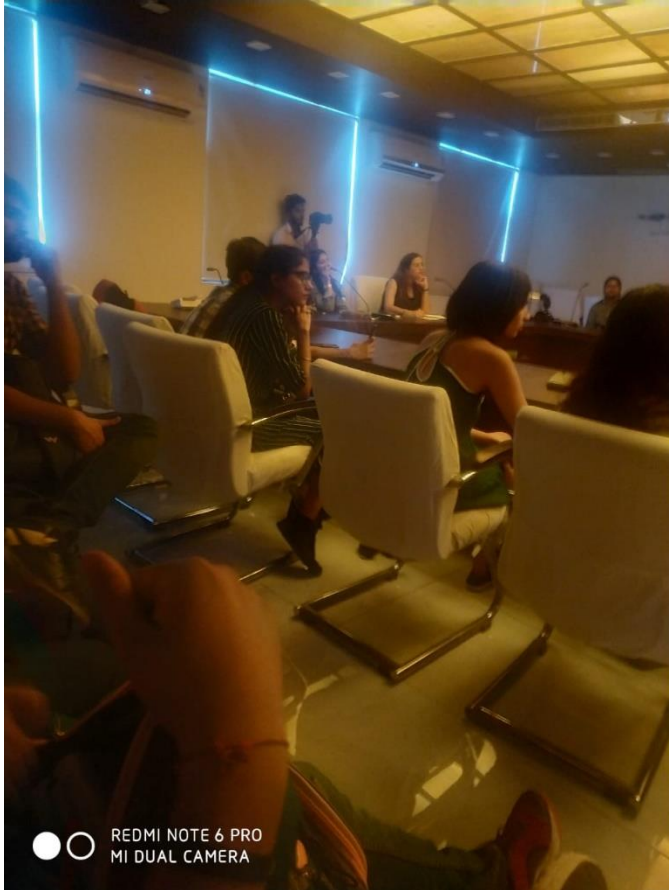
- **BPIT REPORT**

Ananya, The Unparalleled conducted 2 online events during Online Elements Culmyca, the show must go on.

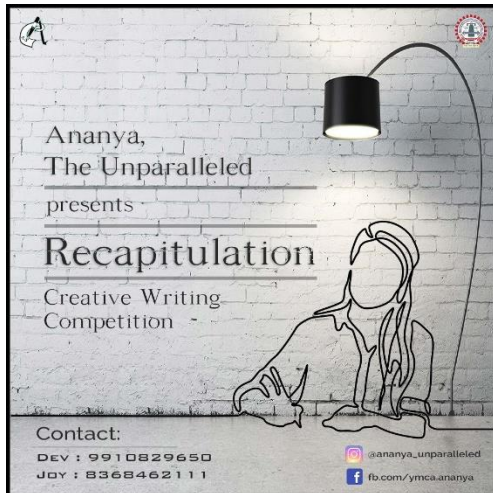

Recapitulation was an online creative writing event in which participants gave their write ups on one of the given photos provided by us.

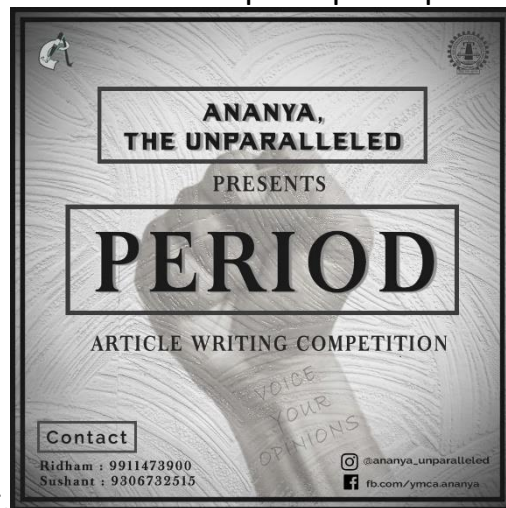

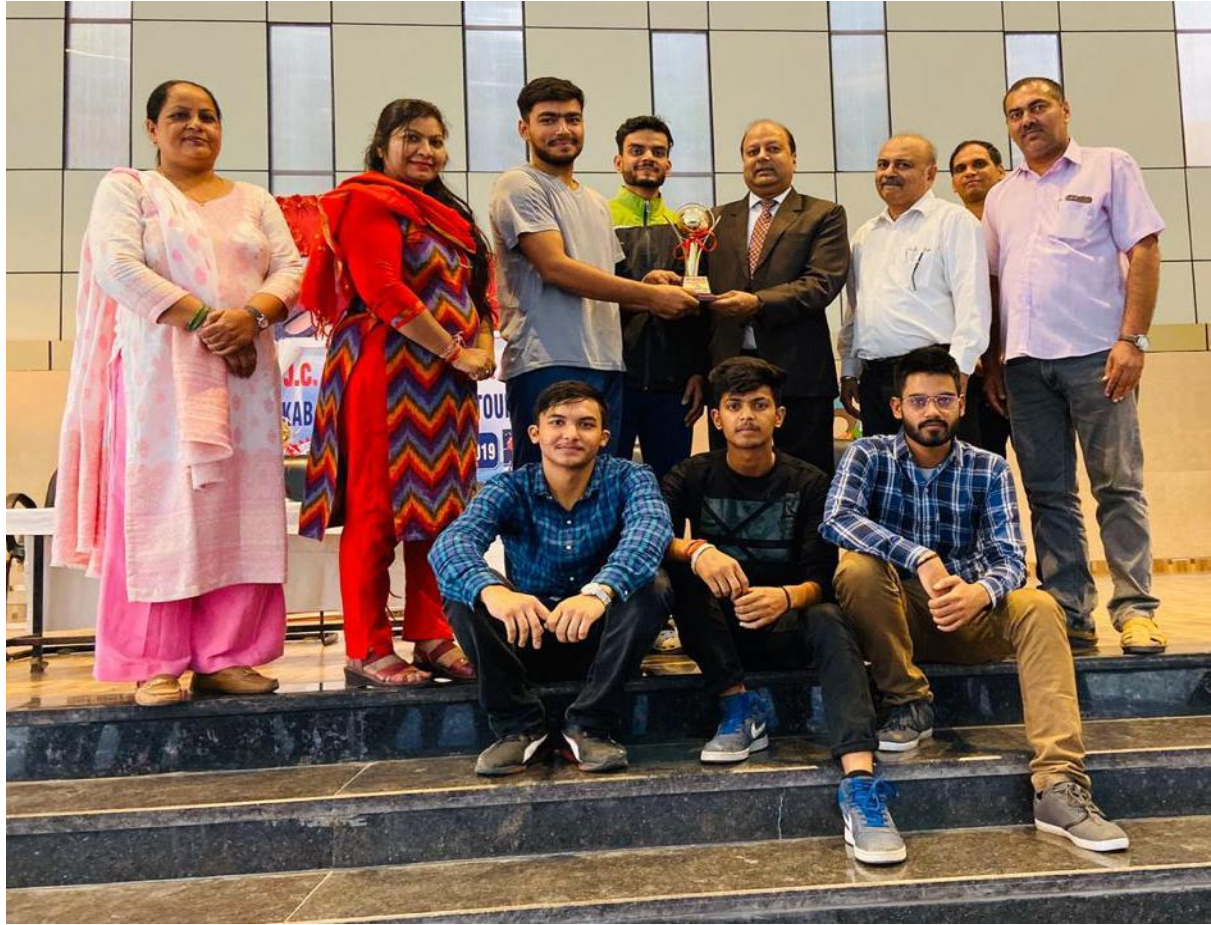

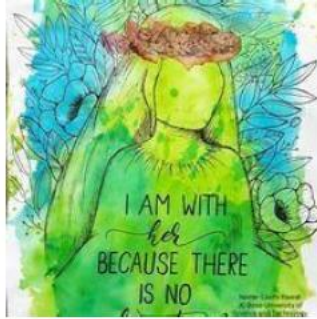
